Parent / Carers Survey

Attendance

Student success at school is directly linked to how often a student attends. Regular attendance is 90% which means that a student can only be absent one day a fortnight to maintain regular attendance. This requires parents and caregivers to further support their children to get to school to be able to achieve to their full potential. Lack of attendance does have a significant effect on your children's ability to learn. As the table below shows a child that regularly attends school still misses 4 weeks of school in a year.

Informing the school your child/ren will be absent
