## PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to all of the parents who have downloaded and are using the Compass App for attendance, and just to see other information about your children here at school. Our greatest challenge is that those people setting up each of the email and notification templates that you get, such as for behaviour incidents and uniform, don't get to see what it looks like from the 'parent side'. Sometimes your version is the same as ours, sometimes it is less. Thank you to those parents who have raised issues and asked questions that have led to us making changes so that parents have a 'better experience' with Compass. For example, parents can now also see the reasons why their child was sent to buddy class. We can't change all of the templates, but where we can we are looking to make improvements.

I have also begun sending out attendance letters in regards to 2025 overall attendance and our aims for your child's attendance at school this year. This has also included letters of appreciation and thanks for students with regular attendance. With another end of term reward being planned for students with 85% or better attendance, no loss of Good Standing and 85% or better uniform in secondary, our aim is that we get as many students as possible achieving this.

Our first Student Council event is being held next week. Please remember that to help with planning, catering and supervision we now have a date by which students need to register. NO late registrations will be accepted. If you are a bus parent and for this event wish the school to supervise your child/ren attending from 3.00-3.15pm, please ring the office to notify us and tell your child to go straight to the undercover area after school. If your child is registered and then isn't going to be attending, please ring the office during the day to advise us - we want to make sure your child is home safe with you and not missing when they don't turn up. At the end of the event, all parents must come to collect their child from the undercover area. They are not permitted to walk home unsupervised.



## FUNDRAISING

With Year 6 Camp and Countryweek camps we rely heavily on parent fundraising activities to keep these events affordable for parents. Our camps could not proceed without this support. But that also means we need as many parents as possible to step in and help out with the fundraising. Our camp meetings were held last night and information will be coming to parents about the events planned and how they can help out with fundraising.



## DRESS CODE

We have started reminding students that, as per our dress code policy, students with collar length or longer hair must be tied back for hygiene and safety. Please note that this includes girls AND boys. Hair ties will be provided as needed to students who do not have one.

## SECONDARY ELECTIVES AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

To enable more students to participate in electives of their choice in Years 7 to 10, we have made the decision to make all electives free for students. Parents were informed of this and students given the opportunity to reselect their choices for this semester. Similarly, we have made the same decision for the secondary swimming program which is happening at the pool this term. Where parents have already paid for swimming, those funds will remain as a credit for parents to use to fund other school activities for their child/ren.


